

Sublime Text 2 Cheat Sheet

All the commands of Sublime Text 2 can be accessed from the command palette.

Ctrl ↑ P Command palette

Goto Anywhere

Ctrl P Go to file
Ctrl R Go to symbol (@)
Ctrl ; Go to word (#)
Ctrl G Go to line number (:)

Editing

Ctrl X Delete line
Ctrl ↵ Insert line after
Ctrl ↑ ↵ Insert line before
Ctrl ↑ ↑ Move line/selection up
Ctrl ↑ ↓ Move line/selection down
Ctrl K, K Delete from cursor to end of line
Ctrl K, ← Delete from cursor to start of line
Ctrl] Indent current line(s)
Ctrl [Unindent current line(s)
Ctrl ↑ D Duplicate line(s)
Ctrl / (Un)comment current line
Ctrl ↑ / Block (un)comment current selection
Ctrl Y Repeat last keyboard command
Ctrl ↑ V Paste and indent correctly
Ctrl Space Select next auto-completion suggestion
Ctrl K, U Uppercase
Ctrl K, L Lowercase

Selection

Ctrl L Select line — Repeat to select next lines
Ctrl D Select word — Repeat to select other occurrences
Ctrl ↑ M Select all contents of the current parentheses
Alt ↑ ↑ Insert selection cursor one line up
Alt ↑ ↓ Insert selection cursor one line down

You can select a rectangular section by using ↑, then holding the right mouse button and dragging over the area you wish to select. You can add or remove part of the selection using modifiers keys and using the same technique.

Alt Remove from selection
Ctrl Add to selection

Navigation

Ctrl M Jump to closing parentheses — Repeat to go to opening parentheses
Ctrl U Jump to your last change — Repeat to undo change

Bookmarks

Ctrl F2 Toggle bookmark
F2 Next bookmark
↑ F2 Previous bookmark
Ctrl ↑ F2 Clear bookmarks

Tabs

Ctrl PgUp Previous tab
Ctrl PgDn Next tab
Alt [NUM] Switch to tab number [NUM]

Find/Replace

Ctrl f Find
Ctrl h Replace
Ctrl ↑ f Find in files

General

Ctrl K, B Toggle side bar
Ctrl ↑ Alt P Show scope in status bar

Packages

Alignment

Ctrl Alt A Align selected lines

Sublime Files

Ctrl Super N Open file navigator

SublimeCodeIntel

Super F3
Alt click Jump to symbol definition

Origami

Use Ctrl K, then use Ctrl arrows with modifiers :
no modifier Travel to adjacent pane
↑ Carry the current file to destination
Alt Clone the current file to destination
Super Create an adjacent pane
Super ↑ Destroy an adjacent pane

Wrap Plus

Alt Q Wrap selection

LaTeXTools

↑ Super ↑ Exponent with braces
↑ Super ↓ Subscript with braces

Hex Viewer

Use Ctrl ↑ B, then :
Ctrl ↑ H Toggle hex editor mode
Ctrl ↑ I Show hex inspector
Ctrl ↑ F Hex finder
Ctrl ↑ E Hex editor
Ctrl ↑ X Hex writer
Ctrl ↑ U Discard edits
Ctrl ↑ = Hex checksum
Ctrl ↑ - Hash selection
Ctrl ↑ G Hash evaluation
